## Ministry Descriptions

**ADULT FAITH BOARD:** Plans and implements adult faith programming, including Lenten Evenings of Faith, Parish Retreats and Missions, and other catechetical and faith formation activities.

**ART AND ENVIRONMENT:** Helps prepare the church for special seasons and celebrations.

#### **ASSUMPTION AMBASSADORS:**

Distribute flyers about Masses and special events to local hotels approximately 6 times a year.

**ASSUMPTION YOUNG ADULTS:** Minister at the 5:00 p.m. Mass on the third Sunday of the month and participate in various service projects and social activities. For anyone in their twenties or thirties, married or single.

**BIBLE STUDY:** A weekly video based study of Scripture.

#### **COMMUNICATIONS COMMITTEE:**

Oversees our electronic and print communications and publicizes parish events.

**EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT:** Opportunity for contemplative prayer. People needed to keep Jesus company.

**FINANCE COMMITTEE:** Assists the pastor in financial planning and oversight and in maintenance and improvement of parish facilities. Membership is by appointment only.

**GARDEN CLUB:** Cares for the green space just west of the church.

**GREETERS/USHERS:** Welcome parishioners and visitors, find seats for worshippers when the church is crowded, collect and secure church offerings, and arrange for gift bearers at Mass.

HOSPITALITY COMMITTEE: Plans and implements various social functions throughout the year. They host the monthly coffee after Sunday Mass, the annual Christmas bake sale and other parish events.

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS: The nation's oldest Catholic fraternal organization seeks to serve the parish, the church, and the larger community through charity, service, and Christian witness.

**LECTORS:** Proclaim the Word of God at weekday and Sunday Masses.

**MINISTERS OF CARE:** Upon completion of a training program, may bring Communion to the sick, hospitalized and shut ins.

**MINISTERS OF THE EUCHARIST:** Assist with the distribution of Communion at Masses.

MUSIC MINISTRY: Choir sings at the 10:30 a.m. Sunday Mass twice monthly and at special Masses. The contemporary group leads worship at 5:00 p.m. Mass on the 3rd Sunday of the month. Instrumentalists are needed for both.

PASTORAL COUNCIL: Assists the Pastor by investigating pastoral matters, considering them thoughtfully, and proposing practical conclusions. Members are discerned to serve a three year term.

**RCIA:** Prepares adults for the sacraments of Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation. Sponsors and leaders needed.

**SERVITE SECULAR ORDER:** Community of lay men and women who seek to grow spiritually by following the example of the Seven Holy Founders of the Order of Servants of Mary.

## **SPECIAL EVENTS/FUNDRAISER:**

Committees are required to plan and execute events like our annual Italian Dinner and Homecoming. Volunteers are always needed.

#### **SOCIAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE:**

Advocates for positive social change in society according to Catholic principles.

**TAIZE:** A monthly participant led prayer service according to the prayer form developed in Taize, France.
