The recent experience of using the downstairs hall for the crowd attending a weekday service, was a positive experience for moving forward in handling an "overflow" crowd. Pre-registration and scheduling of volunteers will be necessary for accommodating the Christmas services. Diversity of Church Artwork- David presented options or estimates for potential statues for addition to our existing artwork. Father Joe will solicit an additional opinion regarding how Kateri Takawitha is perceived within the indigenous community. Another possibility would be Saint Augustine as depicted accurately as one from the North African region. Further discussion took place as to alerting the parish community regarding the potential additions to our existing artwork.
